Respected Sir/Madam,



Community Care Programme (CCP)

The Community Care Programme is being widely utilized by infirm and disabled elderly people in Chennai. Since there was increasing number of elderly requiring this support the nursing aid has stopped visiting institutions to be exclusively available for the elderly in their residence. In the community the nursing aid made about four house visits a day, six days a week and caters to 45-50 elderly persons a month.

World Elder's Day

Many elderly suffer from memory loss, lack of concentration, inability to remember day, date, month etc. To highlight the significance of cognitive impairment among the elderly a rally was organized in collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Madras University and Madras School of Social Work. The rally was flagged off by Ms. Mohini Actor from Tamil film Industry. A copy of the memorandum was given to His Excellency the Governor of Tamil Nadu, Thiru Surjit Singh Barnala. Also a copy of the memorandum has been submitted to the Regional Director for Disabilities.

Vijayaraghavan Memorial Day

The Vijayaraghavan Memorial Day was celebrated on two occasions – one on his birthday and another on his death anniversary. On both occasions as per the request of the family members feeding was organized in an orphanage.
